The Commissioners signed a Petition to Abandon a Portion of Ovando Township Montana Third Judicial District Court Cause No. CV-2014.



Jody Walker, Clerk and Recorder, presented the correspondence.


Bret and Karen Gregor were in to discuss harassment by a neighbor in Gold Creek.

The Commissioners went to Gold Creek with Sheriff Howard to view the Gregor property. They also went to Garrison to look at an easement encroachment complaint.


